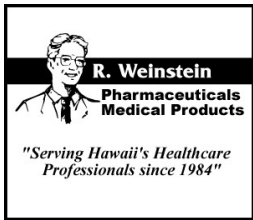

Andrew Kroger, M.D., M.P.H., is a medical officer for the National Center for Immunization and Respiratory Diseases at the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC). As one of the traveling trainers in the Education, Information and Partnership Branch, he has given multiple presentations on topics ranging from immunization updates to pandemic influenza preparedness. Dr. Kroger

trained in pediatrics for two years at Rainbow Babies and Children's Hospital in Cleveland before transferring to Emory University where he specialized in public health and preventive medicine. He received joint Doctor of Medicine and Master of Public Health degrees from Yale Medical School and Yale University School of Epidemiology and Public Health with a concentration in international health.

Ms. Wolicki holds a Bachelor of Science degree in nursing from the University of Detroit/Mercy.
